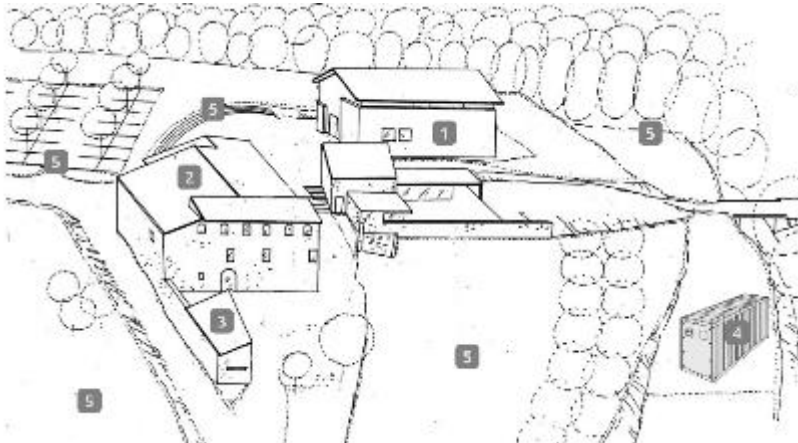


L'ANIMAL A L'ESQUENA

WORKSPACES



L'animal a l'esquena provides artists with a set of spaces that combine heritage buildings, natural surroundings, and high-end technical equipment in support of their projects. The organisation of the centre is structured around the following spaces:

- [1] Studio / performing arts workspace:** Main space for practice, research, and the presentation of processes. Equipped to host residencies, workshops, open showings, and other events.
- [2] Masia / work and meeting spaces:** Symbolic core of the project and highly versatile following its recent renovation within the framework of the “La Casa Vacía” project. It includes open-plan spaces mainly intended for writing residencies and adaptable to other types of use depending on the projects.
- [3] Management office:** Area for coordination and support of projects, centralising the centre's technical and organisational resources during office hours.
- [4] Scenography workshop and storage:** Space intended for the construction, storage, and maintenance of scenic elements and occasionally available for projects involving some type of construction resource.
- [5] Outdoor spaces (forest, fields, threshing floor, natural environment):** A working environment that actively forms part of the creative processes, especially in site-specific proposals and research linked to landscape and nature.

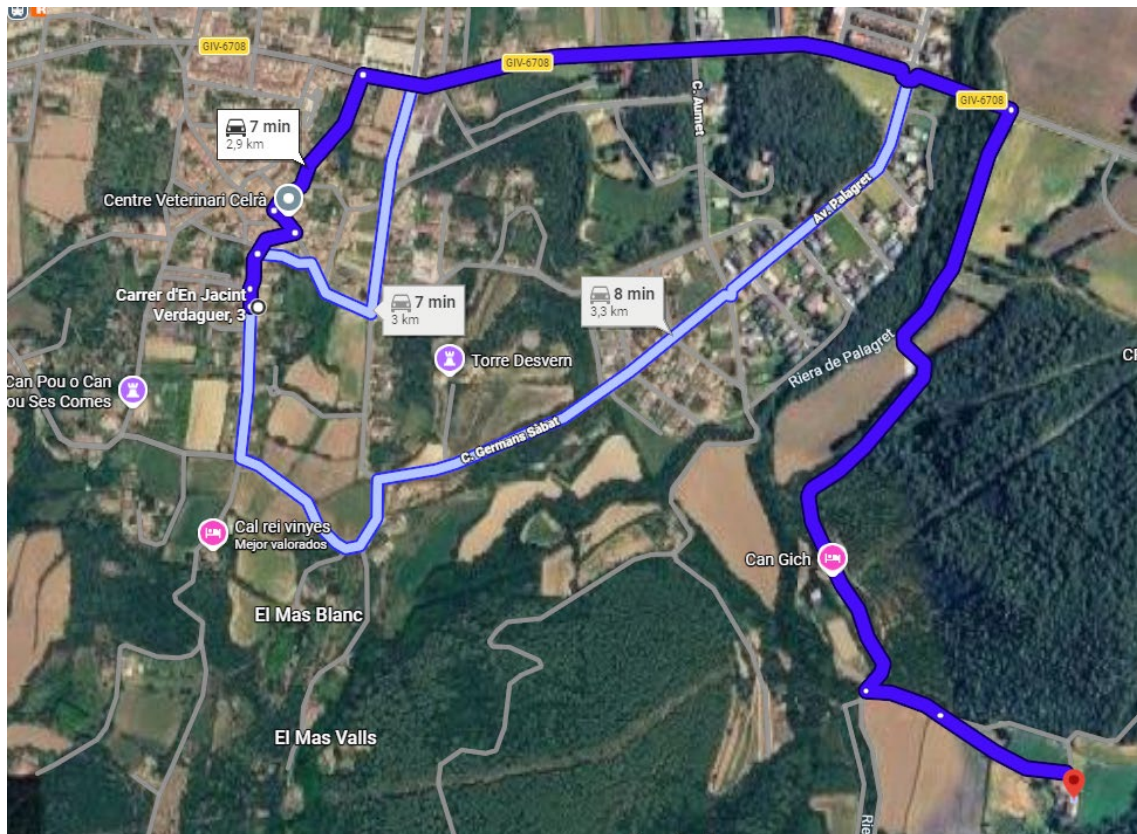
This set of spaces is exceptionally complemented, depending on the projects and subject to availability from the Town Council of Celrà, by access to the Teatre Ateneu de Celrà, which allows the development of production and presentation phases under the technical conditions of a conventional performing arts venue.

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ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation for residents is located in a house in the village of Celrà, at Carrer Jacint Verdaguer 3, 2 kilometres from L'animal a l'esquena, where the workspaces described above are located.



The house has several floors and capacity for different residents:

- 4 rooms with double beds
- 1 room with two single beds
- Possibility of adding up to 3 extra single beds in open spaces

The house includes:

- Fully equipped kitchen. Operates with butane gas.
- Living room with fireplace and available firewood + programmable diesel heating
- 1 full bathroom with shower
- Terrace
- Washing machine
- Wifi

RULES FOR THE USE OF THE SPACES

In order to care for the shared spaces and encourage good coexistence during the residencies, we ask you to take the following guidelines into account:

Use and care of the spaces

- Use the spaces, equipment, and materials carefully and responsibly.
- Leave the spaces tidy after each use and inform the team in the event of any incident or damage.
- Consult beforehand before moving any type of technical installation.
- Do not leave behind materials, scenography, or waste.
- No space or material may be used without prior consent from the technical team.

Cleaning and coexistence

- Keep shared areas clean, both in the house and in the workspaces.
- Avoid leaving food or food remains in kitchens, the studio, or coffee break areas in order to prevent insects or the presence of animals.
- Respect the rest and coexistence of other residents and users of the spaces.

Natural environment and recycling

- Care for and respect the natural environment and shared outdoor areas, removing any materials used once the work is finished.
- Follow the recycling and waste separation system indicated in the house and avoid leaving rubbish in indoor or outdoor spaces.

Arrival and departure

- Return the keys at the end of the residency and try to leave the spaces in good condition for the next residents.
- Leave the used bed linen and towels in the laundry area before departure.
